Liturgy Tip

"The supplication Agnus Dei (Lamb of God), is, as a rule, sung by the choir or cantor with the congregation responding; or it is, at least, recited aloud". General Instruction of the Roman Missal No 83.

Explanation of the Tip: the Choir or Cantor sings alone "Jesus, Lamb of God, you take away the sins of the world" and the congregation joins in singing the response "have mercy on us". This is repeated once; the third time the congregation's response changes to "grant us peace".

Saints of the Week

Wednesday, October 28th: Saint Simon, Apostle, called "the Canaanite" and also "the Zealot," an anti-Roman party; possibly preached in Egypt and Persia.

Saint Jude or Thaddeus ("Courageous"), Apostle, may have preached in Palestine and Persia; patron of those in despair, or in hopeless situations (perhaps because of the similarity of his name with that of Judas Iscariot, who betrayed Jesus and despaired).
